FISHER CATS TAKE GAME 3 AT DIAMOND:

The Fisher Cats went to the top of the sixth down 1-0 last night and only one batter had reached, Mike McDade, on a walk in the fifth inning against Richmond starter Jason Stevenson. With two outs in the sixth, six consecutive Fisher Cats reached.

Jonathan Diaz walked, **Anthony Gose** broke up the no-hitter with a single, and both runners scored on wild pitches. **Kevin Howard** walked and scored on a double by **Moises Sierra** for a 3-1 lead. **Travis d'Arnaud** made it 4-1 with a double, and **Mike McDade's** single scored d'Arnaud to make it 5-1. Richmond took a 1-0 lead in the first on a triple by Charlie Culberson and a wild pitch by New Hampshire starter Yohan Pino (4.1 IP- 1 ER- 4 K). **Wes Etheridge** got Chris Dominguez to hit into a double play with the bases loaded and one out in the fifth to keep the score 1-0. Juan Perez singled in Wendell Fairley, who had tripled in the sixth to make it 5-2. Perez singled, moved to third on a single by Ryan Lollis, and scored on a wild pitch in the eighth inning. **Bobby Korecky** earned his fourth save of the post-season with a perfect ninth inning.

OF NOTE: The Fisher Cats are making an appearance in the Eastern League finals for the first time since 2004, when they swept Altoona to win the title...Richmond had an impressive 45-26 home record in the regular season, but the Fisher Cats are now 4-0 at the Diamond in 2011....Last night's crowd was 8819, the highest of the post-season in the Eastern League.

FISHER CATS STARTER DECK MCGUIRE: Richmond native **Deck McGuire** is the scheduled starter for the Fisher Cats tonight. McGuire struggled in a relief outing on Tuesday night in Game 1. He faced four batters and all four reached with two hits and two walks...McGuire was on the DL at the end of season (oblique) after making three starts, including August 2 at the Diamond when he was also matched up against Justin Fitzgerald. McGuire allowed three runs in six innings and the Fisher Cats held on for a 7-6 win. Deck was selected by the Blue Jays in the 1st round of 2010 draft (11th overall) out of Georgia Tech.

LOOKING AHEAD: **RHP Chad Jenkins** would pitch a fifth game, if needed, here at The Diamond at 6:05pm on Sunday. Radio coverage would begin at 5:45pm with Bob Lipman. Jenkins was Toronto's top draft pick in 2009 (20th overall) out of Kennesaw State. Jenkins is 1-0, 3.38 in his two post-season starts, including a no decision in Game 1 of the finals (3.2 IP- 9 H- 4 ER). Jenkins went 1-1, 2.08 in his two starts against the Flying Squirrels in the regular season.
